



FARM POLICIES

- Spring Creek Growers does not guarantee tree availability regarding type or size of trees. The farm is on a first come, first serve basis.
- Spring Creek Growers reserves the right to limit cutting of specific sizes and types of trees to ensure future availability.
- Spring Creek Growers does not guarantee length of selling season. We open Saturday prior to Thanksgiving. Please call or check the website for specific operating hours.
- All pre-cut trees are individually priced. All choose and cut trees (in the field) are priced by type and height. Price guide for choose and cut trees is provided at greeting.
- For your safety, please observe all posted signs regarding farm animal viewing, hayrides, activities and fire pit. Spring Creek Growers will follow CDC, local and state guidelines regarding COVID policies. These will include masks to be worn inside our farmhouse gift shop and bakery and whenever social distancing is not possible. Sanitation protocols will be done. Hand sanitizers and hand wash stations will be made available to everyone. Outdoor seating and dining will be available.
- Spring Creek Growers is a non-smoking facility.
- Dogs are allowed on the farm but must be kept on a leash at all times. Waste removal bags are available free of charge at the greeting station.
- Tree tie-on is offered as a courtesy. It is the driver's responsibility to secure the tree to the vehicle.
- If you are only coming to the farm to take photos, fees and guidelines apply. All professional/amateur photography must be booked in advance on our website and no professional photography is allowed after Thanksgiving Day. All appointment times are prior to that date and must be booked online.
- Refund policy—all tree sales are final.
- Group nighttime hayrides and campfire rentals are available and must be booked in advance.
- The last hayride to the fields departs at 5:15 p.m. This ensures you have time to select your tree and process it before dark. The farm closes at 6 p.m.
